





Since mid-March 2011 up until December 2016, VDC was able to document 171,886 battlerelated deaths.




Since mid-March 2011 until end of December 2016, VDC was able to document 108,322 civilians and 63,564 non-civilians battle-related deaths.

Who is responsible for civilian casualties in Syria since mid-March 2011 until December 2016, based on the Violations Documentation Centre in Syria database.






First, December Battle-Related Deaths:


During this month VDC was able to document a total of **896** deaths across different Syrian governorates, among them, **810** were documented by full name and **86** are still registered as unknown.



Fourth, Death by Type of Weapon:

286 of the total 896 of the battlerelated death occurred by firearms and snipers, 326 by aerial attacks and barrel bombs, while tanks, cannons, and mortars accounted for 183 battle-related deaths. Additionally, the VDC was able to document the deaths of 101 under other reasons; fifteen deaths under torture in the Syrian






government detention centers, **2** due to the lack of medical and food resources in besieged areas and **34** by land mines planted by ISIS, 36 as a result of being exposed to the Chlorine gas in Aleppo, **6** were kidnaped by unknown. While for the rest **8** the cause or the executioner was not undoubtedly identified.

Total number of males over 18 is 633, while the number is 88 for adult females over 18 years old. Total children battle-related deaths are 175 with 114 males and 61 females







Sixth, Deaths by ISIS:

During this month, VDC was able to document the death of 45 people, 23 are civilians, and 22 from different armed groups.
